- * Autograph types are Print Upper Lower Case (John Mark Brown) or Script (*John Mark Brown*)
Always have by: line in front of your autograph types.
- Red ink is used for Autographs on Deeds i.e.: Deed of Re-Conveyance & Baby Deed. (All typed words on Baby Deed is in RED INK). /If American State Nat/Cit use Blue ink/Red Thumb © (handwritten), ARR, WOP.
- Ask about Power of Attorneys that should not be terminated / superseded.
- LOITN/A "Letter of Intent to Naturalize or Assimilate".
- Naturalized — Is used for a U.S. Citizen. - Assimilated - Is used for a non-U.S. Citizen.
- All Names used, nick, pen, stage, business and user name, etc.
- Start by going to the Land Recording Office at <https://members.americanstatenationals.us/> and creating an account, including completing your profile information, uploading your passport style photo and Red Thumb print. Purchase a publishing credit. After you get your Documents published you will be able to order a Credentials Card, NOT AN ID! Having Documents notarized by a Notary Public, will cause less problems publishing them at a County Recorder of Deeds office or Land Recording Office or Self-Publication in local newspapers.
- Declaration of the Naturalization Act of July 1779. Witness Testimony Affirming Identity (x2 – 2 people you have known 7+ years). Recording and publishing these documents will put you back on the Land and soil as an American State National! However, until you record and publish your 928 documents and Notice Letters, you will not be eligible to serve as a State Citizen in the Missouri Assembly (Jural, Militia, etc.).
- 928 Documents. Witness Testimony Affirming Identity (x2 – 2 people you have known 7+ years). These documents need to be recorded by a Notary Public and published in a Recorder of Deeds Office (?) or the Land Recording Office (\$25.00) or Newspapers (?). You might want to include any optional documents with your original publishing. If you want to participate in The Missouri Assembly scan your originals in color. Make sure you have a publishing credit on your LRO Account and mail or email them to a Missouri Assembly Recording Secretary for publishing. If mailed, please enclose a prepaid, self-addressed envelope and make copies before mailing.
- Notice Letters – should be included in your publishing, those all need to be sent via Registered Mail w/Return Receipt, with registered mail number printed on the letter in the space provided. Scan a color copy of the letters, with Registered Mail number written on them, prior to mailing. Or send the letters via Priority Mail, with number printed on the letter in the space provided, which is Tracked with proof of delivery. Or First-Class Mail with Proof of delivery. Once mailed, scan a color copy of the stamped proof of mailing and then make sure you have a publishing credit. Send the scanned letters and matching proof of mailing to a Missouri Assembly Recording Secretary for publishing. If you want your originals returned to you, please make prior arrangements.
